The set speed can be decreased in steps of 1 mph (2 km/h), by briefly pressing control (4).

## SUSPENDING AND RESUMING THE CRUISE SPEED

Suspend cruise control with a single press of control (3).

To resume cruise control at the previous set speed, press control (**2**).

## NOTICE

It is not recommended to resume set speed when a low gear is selected as excessive engine speeds will occur. (2) should be used only if the driver is aware of the set speed and intends to return to it.

## **AUTOMATIC SWITCH OFF**

Cruise control will switch off but the set speed will remain in the memory when:

- The CAN button (3) is pressed.
- The brake pedal is pressed.
- Speed falls below 18mph (30km/h.
- Transmission N, P or R is selected.
- Dynamic Stability Control is operating.
- The difference between the actual and set speed is too great.
- The vehicle reaches a speed of 105 mph (170 km/h).
- The accelerator pedal is used to accelerate beyond the set speed for too long a period.

Cruise control will switch off and clear the memory when:

- The ignition is switched off.
- A fault occurs. The cruise control system will switch off and cannot be used until the fault is cleared.
