

SYMBOLS USED IN THIS HANDBOOK



This safety alert symbol precedes any safety message about a risk of personal injury. It will also have one of the following signal words.

⚠ DANGER

Indicates a hazardous situation which, if not avoided, will result in death or serious injury.

⚠ WARNING

Indicates a hazardous situation which, if not avoided, could result in death or serious injury.

⚠ CAUTION

Indicates a hazardous situation which, if not avoided, could result in minor or moderate injury.

NOTICE

Indicates either a procedure which must be followed precisely, or information that should be considered with great care, in order to avoid the possibility of damage to your vehicle.



This recycling symbol identifies items that must be disposed of safely in order to prevent unnecessary damage to the environment.



This symbol identifies those items that must be disposed of correctly, as they contain harmful substances. Seek advice on disposal from your Land Rover Retailer/Authorized Repairer and/or your local authority.



This symbol identifies features that can be adjusted, disabled or enabled by a Land Rover Retailer/Authorized Repairer.
