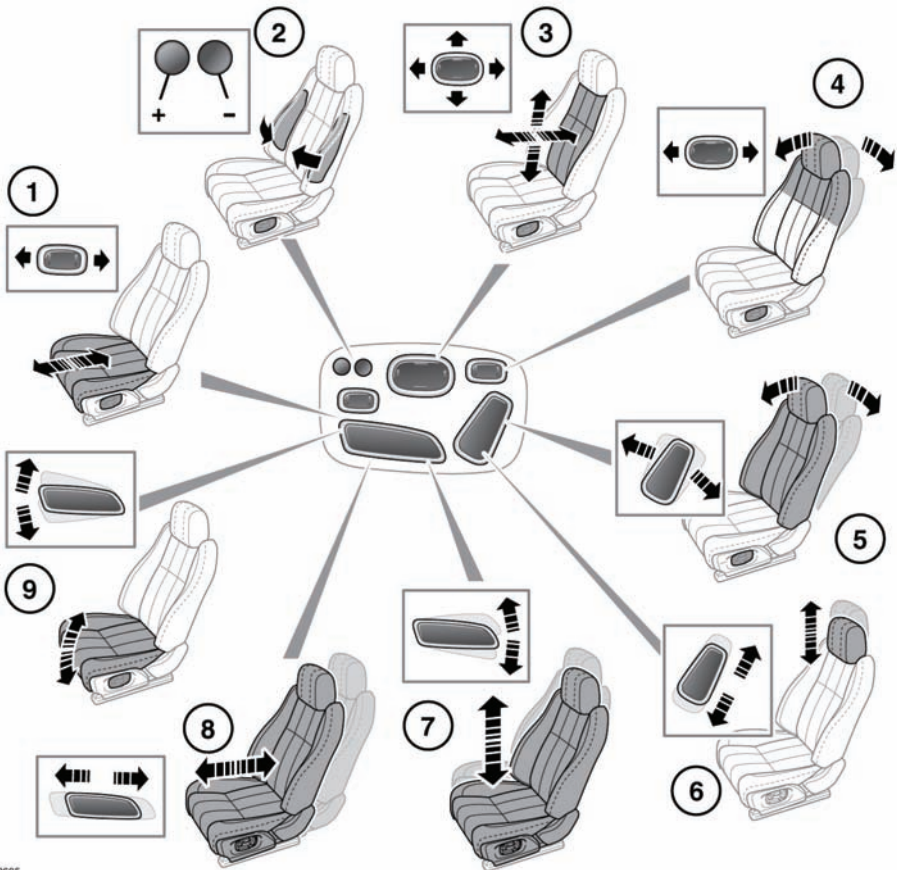


MISLOCK

Note: Operating the interior or exterior door handles, while attempting to unlock, lock, or change the child lock status of the vehicle (including Drive-away locking), may cause the security system to ignore any unlock, lock, or child lock requests.

FRONT SEATS

Do not adjust the driver's seat while the vehicle is moving. Doing so could cause loss of vehicle control and personal injury.

Note: *This diagram covers all electric seat controls. Not all of these controls apply to all seats.*

1. Cushion length.
2. Bolster inflate/deflate.
3. Lumbar support.
4. Seat upper back angle.
5. Seat back angle.
6. Head restraint height.
7. Seat height.
8. Forward and rearward position.
9. Cushion tilt.

The front seats may also have:

- Heated/climate control.
- Seat massage.
