

1. Press and hold **AUDIO/SETUP** to open the setup menu.
2. Select **BLUETOOTH**.
3. Select **VISIBLE M**.
4. Select **VISI M ON** or **VISI M OFF** to select between visible and invisible respectively.

Note: The default setting is **VISI M ON** (visible).

PAIRING AND CONNECTING USING THE PHONE

Note: Up to three devices can be stored. If a device is already connected, disconnect it before pairing additional devices. Refer to the device manufacturer's instructions for further information.

1. Search for the audio system using the telephone. Refer to the telephone manufacturer's instructions for further information.
2. Select **PAIR YES** using the menu select control. Once connected the system will return to the previous selected audio source.

Note: Certain telephones may ask for a 4 digit Personal Identification Number (PIN). In this case, enter 4 zeros ('0000').

Note: The telephone will re-pair automatically whenever the audio system is switched on. If it fails to reconnect, follow the pairing procedure to pair the telephone manually.

PAIRING AND CONNECTING USING THE AUDIO SYSTEM

1. Press and hold **AUDIO/SETUP** to open the setup menu.
2. Select **BLUETOOTH**.
3. Select **SEARCH DEV**.

Note: The search can be interrupted by pressing the back button.

4. Select the desired device using the menu select control. Once connected the system will return to the previous selected audio source.

Note: Certain telephones may ask for a 4 digit Personal Identification Number (PIN). In this case, enter 4 zeros ('0000').

Note: The telephone will re-pair automatically whenever the audio system is switched on. If it fails to reconnect, follow the pairing procedure to pair the telephone manually.

CHANGING THE CONNECTED PHONE

1. Press and hold **AUDIO/SETUP** to open the setup menu.
2. Select **BLUETOOTH**.
3. Select **PAIRED DEV**.
4. Select the desired telephone from the list of stored telephones.
5. Select **CONNECT**. The audio system will display a confirmation message.
6. Press and hold the back button to close the setup menu.

DISCONNECTING THE CONNECTED PHONE

1. Press and hold **AUDIO/SETUP** to open the setup menu.
2. Select **BLUETOOTH**.
3. Select **PAIRED DEV**.
4. Select the desired telephone from the list of stored telephones.
5. Select **DISCONNECT**. The audio system will display a confirmation message.
6. Press and hold the back button to close the setup menu.
