- Press and hold AUDIO/SETUP to open the setup menu.
- 2. Select BLUETOOTH.
- 3. Select VISIBLE M.
- Select VISI M ON or VISI M OFF to select between visible and invisible respectively.

Note: The default setting is **VISI M ON** (visible).

PAIRING AND CONNECTING USING THE PHONE

Note: Up to three devices can be stored. If a device is already connected, disconnect it before pairing additional devices. Refer to the device manufacturer's instructions for further information.

- Search for the audio system using the telephone. Refer to the telephone manufacturer's instructions for further information.
- Select PAIR YES using the menu select control. Once connected the system will return to the previous selected audio source.

Note: Certain telephones may ask for a 4 digit Personal Identification Number (PIN). In this case, enter 4 zeros ('0000').

Note: The telephone will re-pair automatically whenever the audio system is switched on. If it fails to reconnect, follow the pairing procedure to pair the telephone manually.

PAIRING AND CONNECTING USING THE AUDIO SYSTEM

- 1. Press and hold **AUDIO/SETUP** to open the setup menu.
- 2. Select BLUETOOTH.
- 3. Select SEARCH DEV.

- **Note:** The search can be interrupted by pressing the back button.
- Select the desired device using the menu select control. Once connected the system will return to the previous selected audio source.

Note: Certain telephones may ask for a 4 digit Personal Identification Number (PIN). In this case, enter 4 zeros ('0000').

Note: The telephone will re-pair automatically whenever the audio system is switched on. If it fails to reconnect, follow the pairing procedure to pair the telephone manually.

CHANGING THE CONNECTED PHONE

- 1. Press and hold **AUDIO/SETUP** to open the setup menu.
- 2. Select BLUETOOTH.
- 3. Select PAIRED DEV.
- **4.** Select the desired telephone from the list of stored telephones.
- **5.** Select **CONNECT**. The audio system will display a confirmation message.
- **6.** Press and hold the back button to close the setup menu.

DISCONNECTING THE CONNECTED PHONE

- Press and hold AUDIO/SETUP to open the setup menu.
- 2. Select BLUETOOTH.
- 3. Select PAIRED DEV.
- **4.** Select the desired telephone from the list of stored telephones.
- Select **DISCONNECT**. The audio system will display a confirmation message.
- **6.** Press and hold the back button to close the setup menu.
