· Daylight running lamps are on.

If a system fault is detected, the headlamps will attempt to move to the central position, and remain stationary. The AFS warning lamp will illuminate to indicate that a fault is present.



If the warning lamp illuminates, contact your Dealer/Authorised Repairer as soon as possible.

## **HEADLAMPS - DRIVING ABROAD**

The headlamps have a beam pattern that eliminates the need to mechanically adjust the lamps or add any external stick-on decals.

To configure the High beam assist system for the side of the road on which you are driving, proceed as follows:

- Using the menu control on the steering wheel, select Vehicle set-up via the Instrument panel menu.
- 2. Select High Beam Assist.
- 3. Select **Drive on Left** or **Drive on Right**, for the side of the road that you are driving on.

## **HEADLAMP LEVELLING**

## (Halogen headlamps only)

Use the headlamp levelling control to account for vehicle loading changes.

Vehicle load	Switch position
Driver only	0
Driver and front seat passenger	0
Driver and passengers in all seats	Rotate down one position from 0
Maximum Gross Vehicle Weight (GVW)	Rotate down two positions from 0
Maximum rear axle load	Rotate down three positions from 0

## **HEADLAMPS - CONDENSATION**

Misting of lamp lenses can occur under some atmospheric conditions. This will not affect the performance of the lamps and will clear during normal operation.
