Wipers and washers

The headlamp power-wash operates on every fifth operation of the screen washer, provided the headlamps are still switched on and approximately 10 minutes have elapsed since the last headlamp wash.

Switching the headlamps or ignition off and back on again, resets the cycle.

Note: The headlamp washers are inhibited when the washer fluid reservoir level is low.

WINTER PARK POSITION

To avoid damage to the bonnet, do not lift the wiper blades, when they are in the normal park position.

When the vehicle is parked, the wipers can be set to park in a higher position than normal. This allows the wiper blades to be lifted from the windscreen to limit the effects of freezing to the glass and to allow the removal of snow, mud and leaves, etc. The wipers Winter park position can be selected from the Vehicle Set-Up menu. See 46, INSTRUMENT PANEL MENU.



Do not drive with the wipers in the Winter park position. The wipers should be returned to the normal park position before driving the vehicle.
