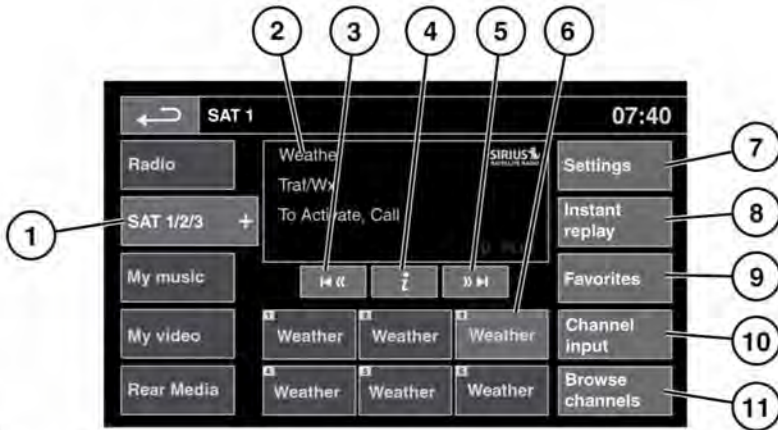


SATELLITE RADIO CONTROLS

⚠ WARNING

Do not adjust the Touch screen controls, or allow the system to distract the driver, while the vehicle is moving. Driver distraction can lead to accidents, causing serious injury or death.

⚠ WARNING

Sustained exposure to high sound levels (greater than 85 decibels) can damage your hearing.

Press the Media menu button, or touch the Media menu soft key from the Touch screen **Home menu** and then select the **SAT Radio** soft key. See **86, TOUCH SCREEN HOME MENU**.

1. Satellite presets page selection:

- Touch to view and select a presets page (**SAT 1, 2 or 3**). The radio will tune to the last used channel on that preset page.

2. Display showing the current channel, the associated category and the relevant radio text.
3. Seek down:
 - Short touch to auto-seek down the frequency to the next available channel.
4. Channel information: Touch to view a pop-up of information broadcast by the channel.
5. Seek up:
 - Short touch to auto-seek up the frequency to the next available channel.
6. Channel presets: Each SAT band has 6 preset positions. These are displayed as weather options when the system is first operated.
 - Touch and release to tune to the channel stored on that preset.
 - Touch and hold to store the current channel on that preset.

- Use the seek buttons on the steering wheel to select the next or previous preset channel.

Note: If a selected preset channel is unsubscribed, or has become unsubscribed, the Sirius phone number and a message will be displayed. See **187, SUBSCRIPTION SETUP**. Only subscribed channels can be saved as presets.

7. **Settings:** Select to view the Settings menu:

- **SIRIUS ID:** Select to view your SIRIUS ID number and subscription contact number.
- **Channel skip:** Select individual channels or entire categories (select **Skip all**) from the list. The selected channels/categories will be skipped when using the seek controls.
- **Parental lock:** Select individual channels or entire categories (**Lock all**) from the list. Locked channels/categories cannot be selected without first entering the correct PIN.

A 4-digit PIN needs to be entered to access the parental lock area. The default PIN is "0000". Select **Edit PIN** to change the PIN.

Note: If the PIN is forgotten, it can be reset by touching and holding **Parental lock** for 10 seconds, then touching and holding **SAT information** for 10 seconds.

- **Audio settings:** Select to adjust the tone and balance audio settings.

8. **Instant replay:** Touch to enter the **Instant replay** menu. Instant replay allows live audio to be paused, rewound and replayed.

Note: The instant replay function cannot save any audio files. All instant replay media will be lost when the vehicle's ignition is switched off.

9. **Favorites:** Touch to save a favorite artist, song or team to the system's memory. Subsequently, if a subscribed channel is broadcasting a song, artist, or team news, and its title is stored in the memory, a pop-up will be displayed giving you the option to tune to that channel. If the memory is full, the option to edit the memory is available on a pop-up screen.

10. **Channel input:** Select to use the numerical touch-pad to enter a channel number. The **OK** soft key can be used, at any time, to enter your selection. If a single number, e.g., 7, is entered, the satellite radio will tune to that channel.

If 07 or 007 is entered, the satellite radio will still tune to the same channel. If **OK** is not touched after numbers are selected, the station will automatically tune to that station following a time-out period.

11. **Browse channels:** Select from the list of categories to view the details (channel number, artist and title of the current track) of the channels in the selected category.

Note: If there is more information than can fit on the display, select **i** to view all the information available.

Select a channel from the list, to tune to that channel (the list is still displayed for further browsing).

INSTANT REPLAY

This feature allows the user to review music tracks already played by the currently received radio station. Tracks are held in an instant replay buffer so that they can be rewound for playing.

With a radio station playing, touch **Instant replay** to enter the feature.

The current **Live** music track will be displayed along with any received information. Use the **Add song**, **Add artist**, or **Add team** soft keys to include the song or artist in the lists of favorites.

Use the standard set of audio control soft keys to rewind, fast forward, stop, play and pause the buffered content. If the pause button is used, the counter will display how far the music track is behind Live play. The blue ball is an indication of the current playing position within the buffer.

Select **Playlist** to view the list of music tracks in the buffer.

The current **LIVE** music track is highlighted. Use the scroll keys to move up or down the list. Touch an alternative track to play. The **i** soft key will display any further information.

To return to the satellite radio screen and exit **Instant replay**, touch **Exit**. To return to the satellite radio screen and continue replay, touch the Back arrow at the top of the screen. To move back to the **Live** screen, long touch the **Instant replay** soft key.

Note: When an alternative radio channel is selected, the playlist will be cleared. The playlist will also clear when the ignition is switched off.

SUBSCRIPTION SETUP

Satellite (SAT) radio is a subscription-based service provided by SIRIUS, providing a wide range of music, news, sport, and talk entertainment channels. Satellite radio provides digital radio across a much wider geographical range than terrestrial radio signals.

Channel 185 (The Sirius Preview Channel) is available as a preview channel. To receive further satellite radio stations, you will need to subscribe to SIRIUS.

From inside your vehicle, call SIRIUS using the displayed number. You will need your credit card details and the SIRIUS ID number (also displayed on-screen).

Note: With a **Bluetooth®** wireless technology enabled phone paired and connected to the vehicle, you can touch the **green** phone icon to call the SIRIUS subscription line.

SATELLITE RADIO RECEPTION

Satellite radio can significantly increase the number of radio channels available.

Where satellite signal strength is adversely affected by terrain, ground transmitters are used to relay the signal.

Note: If any auxiliary electrical equipment is connected to the vehicle, then this may reduce the radio sound quality.

SIGNAL ACQUIRING

If the satellite signal is lost, or not found, **Acquiring** will be shown on the display. If the signal is not regained within a few seconds, all of the relevant soft keys will be inhibited. The dotted line after **Acquiring** will flash until the channel is regained. When the signal has been regained, the selected channel will again play.

Note: This is not the same as No Subscription. The system is only informing the driver that it cannot find the signal, perhaps caused by driving alongside tall buildings and trees, or driving under bridges and tunnels.
